

Mixed Foursomes Championship

Status of Event

Board Event (Gross Winners)

Format

Mixed Foursomes 36 Holes Stroke Gross. The best 8 pairs, plus ties, from Round 1, are eligible to play in the Round 2. Players in Round 2 will play in a seeded draw at times to be determined by the Match Committee.

Trophies

All pairs compete for a single trophy, the Latrobe Mixed Foursomes Championship trophy. There is also a Runners-Up Trophy and a Best Nett Score trophy for competitors in Round 1.

Dates

Round 1: Sunday 1 October 2006.

Round 2: Sunday 8 October 2006.

Eligibility

Open to all 6 and 7 day members.

Handicaps

Not applicable for the gross event. Handicap of the day for the nett event. Handicaps of both players must be recorded on the scorecard; the applicable handicap for determining the winners of the nett event will be the average of the two handicaps.

Entry

Players must enter the Competition of the Day for Round 1. Players playing in Round 2 are not required to enter the Competition of the Day.

Tees

Round 1

Male players will play from the White Tee Markers of the Day, female players from the Red Tee Markers of the Day. Male players will play first from the scorecard's **even-numbered tees**, female players will play first from the scorecard's **odd-numbered tees**.

Round 2

Male players will play from the Blue Tee Markers, female players from the Back Tee Markers. Male players will play first from the scorecard's **odd-numbered tees**, female players will play first from the scorecard's **even-numbered tees**.

Ties

Gross Event

Winner

Where two or more pairs have the same lowest gross score after 36 holes the winner will be determined by the lowest total score in a play-off on Holes 1, 4 and 18, played at the conclusion of Round 2. Pairs with the same lowest total score after 3 holes will continue in sudden-death format on Holes 1, 4, 18, etc, until a winner is determined.

Runners-Up

In the event that no play-off is required to determine the winner, where two or more pairs have the same second-lowest gross score after 36 holes, the Runners-up will be determined by the Australian Countback System.

In the event that a play-off is required to determine the winner, the Runners-Up will be the pair/s who were last eliminated in the play-off.

Tees

Male players will play from the Blue Tee Markers, female players from the Back Tee Markers. Male players will play first on Holes 1 and 18, female players will play first on Hole 4. In the event that a winner is not determined after the third play-off hole, the alternating order shall be continued as commenced at the first play-off hole; that is, females shall play first at the 4th play-off hole, males at the 5th, and so on.

Nett Event

Ties after 18 holes will be resolved by the Australian Countback System, using one half of the relevant aggregate handicap fraction.

Booking and Groups

Competitors may book preferentially from Sunday 17 September 2006. A maximum of three pairs may play in the same group.

Motorised Carts

Except with the express permission of the Match Committee, which must be sought prior to the round/s for which its use is requested, a motorised cart cannot be used by any player. The use of a motorised cart will only be permitted in the case of a permanent or temporary disability. The Match Committee may require a medical certificate to be produced to support the use of a motorised cart.

Other

Rules

Competitors should note especially Rule 29, Threesomes and Foursomes.
