1	384	4	377	5	Avoid left off the tee. Careful club selection for uphill approach shot to hold the green.
2	347	4	320	4	Avoid left off the tee. Try to stay below the hole on the green.
3	152	3	140	3	No good spots if you miss the green – short is the best other option.
4	538	5	417	5	Your approach to a green surrounded by water is key. Green is big, sloping – and fast.
5	477	5	401	5	Fairway narrows to a small and narrow green. Try to keep the ball below the hole.
6	318	4	290	4	Safer to play the dog-leg rather than cutting the corner over the Norfolk pines.
7	366	4	315	4	Aim towards left tree-line as the slope brings the ball back to the middle of the fairway.
8	160	3	135	3	Check your club selection as the green is deeper than you think.
9	360	4	306	4	Drive towards the mounds, well away from the water to the right of the fairway.

10	400	4	341	4	Must hit the fairway. On approach right of the green is safer.
11	358	4	270	4	Forget about the pin placement and hit for the centre of the green.
12	330	4	316	4	Must hit the fairway - which slopes right. Try to hit to the front third of this green.
13	383	4	376	5	The green is long and you can run your approach on to the green.
14	155	3	130	3	Avoid missing the green to the right – short left is the safe option.
15	510	5	450	5	Favour left side from the tee but aim to approach from right of the fairway bunker.
16	399	4	274	4	Hit for the corner. Check club selection for shot to large sloping elevated green.
17	180	3	161	3	Forget about the pin position and hit towards the middle of the green.
18	486	5	393	5	Trouble (bunkers, natural slope) is at the green end – so take care with your approach.
