



Constitution of Peregian Springs Veteran Golfers' Club

1. The name of the Club shall be Peregian Springs Veteran Golfers' Club hereinafter referred to as "The Club". It shall consist of at least 20 members who are shareholders of Peregian Springs Golf Club.
2. The objects for which The Club is established are.
 - To conduct the affairs of The Club within the ambit of the Peregian Springs Golf Club constitution. Subject to this constitution the Management Committee shall have power from time to time to make, rescind or amend rules for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the club.
 - To assist veteran golfers in the Peregian Springs Golf Club in matters relating to the playing of the game of golf.
 - To stimulate interest in veteran golfers by the arrangement of various competitions from time to time in the game of golf **and any social activities as decided.**
 - To arrange sponsorships and the provision of trophies and to accept any gifts or trophies donated.
 - To print and publish material that the club considers desirable for the promotion of its objectives.
 - To raise money by means approved by The Club.
 - To invest and deal with monies not immediately required, in such a manner as may be determined by the Committee from time to time.
 - To subsidise, donate, gift, subscribe, or in any other rightful manner pay out sums of money for the promotion and attainment of the objects herein specified.
 - To affiliate with the Sunshine Coast Veteran Golfers' Association, The Queensland Veteran Golfers' Union and the Veteran Golfers' Union.
 - To do all such other things that, are incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects and powers of The Club.
 - ***The assets and income of The Club shall be applied solely in furtherance of its above-mentioned objectives and no portion shall be distributed directly or indirectly to members of The Club except as bona fide compensation for services rendered or expenses incurred on behalf of The Club***
 - Management Committee means the President, the Captain, the Vice Captain, the Secretary, **the Treasurer, the Publicity Officer** and one to four other committee members as may be elected or appointed by the Committee from time to time.



- The membership of The Club shall consist of financial members of Peregian Springs Golf Club and those members of Peregian Springs Country Club who are financial members of any golf club with an AGU handicap system. All members must have attained the age of 55 years.
- The annual general meeting shall be held in November of each year and shall have a quorum of fifteen members. At that meeting all members of the committee shall retire from office but shall be eligible **to offer themselves** for re-election.
- The Management Committee shall have the power to appoint any member of The Club to fill a vacancy on the Management Committee until the next Annual General Meeting.
- The Management Committee shall meet as and when required and shall have the general control and management of The Club.
- At Management Committee meetings and at the Annual General Meeting the Chairman shall have the right of a casting vote to be used if voting numbers are tied.
- This constitution can only be changed following a special general meeting for which 14 days notice has been given to all members.
- This constitution shall be interpreted subject to the constitution of the Queensland Veteran Golfers' Union and shall there be any inconsistency between this constitution and that constitution then the provisions of that constitution shall prevail.
- ***In the event of The Club being dissolved, the amount that remains after such dissolution and the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities shall be transferred to another organization with similar purposes which is not carried on for the profit or gain of its individual members.***
