Ladies Championships

For Full General Conditions & Eligibility for Championships and all Major events

1. Handicap Divisions will apply as follows: A Grade Championship 0 - 18, B Grade 19 - 27, C Grade 28 - 36, D Grade 37 - 45.
2. The Ladies Championships are open to 7 Day, 6 Day, 5 Day, Life, Midweek and Restricted financial members of 3 months standing.
3. Handicaps for the nett event will be frozen as of the closing date for entries to the championships
4. The A Grade Championship will consist of four rounds of stroke play. B Grade and C Grade will consist of three rounds of stroke play and D Grade will consist of two rounds of stroke play. Dates for Championships as listed in the Members Handbook.
5. Best 12 Gross Scores plus ties plus the next best 3 Nett Scores in each Grade to qualify for Championship Final Round Field for D Grade will be cut after 1st Round, Fields for A, B, & C Grades will be cut after second round
6. 1st Round A Grade and B Grade hit off 1st tee, C Grade and D Grade hit off 10th tee.
2nd Round A Grade and C Grade hit off 1st tee, B Grade hit off 10th tee.
3rd A Grade hit off 1st tee.
Final Round of Championships The Best 12 Gross Scores plus ties plus the next 3 Best Nett Scores for all grades hit off 1st tee in the following order - D Grade, C Grade, B Grade then A Grade.
7. The first two rounds will be played in threes in handicap order, then (A - Z), and groups will remain the same for both rounds, unless it is necessary to move players up due to withdrawals. There will be one time slot left empty between grades. The Match Committee reserves the right to vary these conditions if deemed necessary.
8. A draw will be done in Gross Score order for the 3rd and all Grades for final round. If there is a tie, the gross score of the last card posted will determine the order of seeding for the final round.
9. **In the event of a tie for first place,** a play off will take place as soon as cards have been posted and checked. Players will play together with a marker present. The play off will be over three holes with the aggregate score of the three holes to count, then a further three and so on. The holes to be played will be decided by the Match Committee. This applies to all Grades.
In the event of a tie for the runner-up in each Grade, those tied will be considered equal second and share the runner-up position.
Best Aggregate Nett Score is calculated over the total number of rounds played in each Grade.
In the event of a tie, a count back will take place on the last score posted.
10. The D Grade Shield will be open to all financial members with 3 months standing except "Limited Playing" category, with handicaps of 36 - 45 and will be a Nett event played in conjunction with the first round as a day Trophy. The D Grade Shield and D Grade Championship can be won by the same person.
