WOMENS AUSTRALIAN OPEN CHANGES DATES

Announced 20/10/2009....

ANZ Ladies Masters, Royal Pines, 4-7th March, 2010

Womens Australian Open, Commonwealth Golf Club, Victoria, 11-14th March,. 2010

The move is a result of late scheduling changes on the US LPGA Tour, and is necessary to avoid a clash with the opening of their season in South East Asia early next year. The change will also guarantee delivery of the required exposure to domestic and international players next summer.

The ALPGA and co-sanction partners have been supported by sponsors, host venues and the Ten Network. “The dates are likely to work in our favour in terms of strength of field and we look forward to welcoming many of the world’s best players to our major events early next year.”

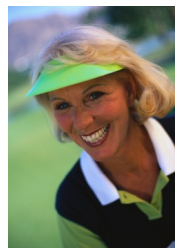

Donation of Annual Event Prizes

Don't forget to check cards and call back scores, also make sure that both player and scorer have signed the card—we have had a few disqualifications which really could have been avoided.

If playing a 4BBB, make sure to check and use your correct handicap—if it is higher you will be disqualified.



Crows (Chip-Ins) is a FREE event.

This opportunity is open to all players and begins on 1st November—31st October each year.

Complete a blank card in the records box and record your 'great' shots!



Handicapping

If you are playing a 4 BBB and you and your partner have a score of 42 Stableford points, (6 up in Par or Net 6 under par in Stroke events) and the individual player's score appears 9 times on the scorecard, **you will be checked for handicapping.**

All scores are converted to Stableford. For the holes where your score has not been recorded the formula is:

Where you **do not** get a handicap stroke then you are given 1 stableford point.

On holes where you **do** get a handicap stroke or more, you are allocated 1.5 Stableford points.

Total is rounded to the lower whole number, 39.5 will be 39. A score of more than 38 points your card will be entered to Golfink as an 'extra' card and your handicap will be adjusted.
