



TEMPORARY LOCAL RULE

Creek Restoration Works Areas

1st – 6th - 7th - 9th Holes

In the area where creek restoration work has been undertaken on the above mentioned holes, playing from the water hazard (defined by yellow and red stakes) is prohibited.

If a player's ball lies in this area or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, the player cannot play the ball as it lies and **must** proceed under **Rule 26-1 a or b**. The ball must be dropped in accordance with the procedures outlined in this rule.

Any areas either side of the water hazard (as defined by white paint or white stakes) are to be treated as GUR and relief **must** be taken with no penalty applied as per **Rule 25-1b**

NB: Entry into the creek is also prohibited
