

LADIES ECLECTIC and BIRDIES COMPETITIONS 2010

Entry is \$25 and the entry fee covers both competitions

Payment is to be made to the Pro Shop.

ECLECTIC COMPETITION

This event will be run in 2 grades on **Ladies SINGLE stroke, stableford and par competition** rounds only. You can enter your score for any round played in a ladies single stroke, stableford or par competition run by the club. That means any SINGLES competition run by the club on any day of the week – including such events as the Garry Crick events, Club Championships, etc.

You must NOT enter scores from 4BBB, Ambrose, Foursomes, Multipliers or any other event where you have a partner or are part of a teams event.

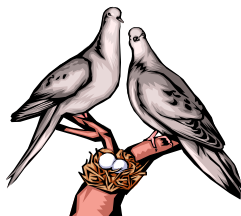


To enter:

1. Select a **sheet from** the front of the folder and place your name on the top
2. Date the first column and enter your GROSS score for each hole. (See attached sample sheet.)
3. File your sheet under the initial of your surname.
4. In following rounds go to your sheet, date the next column and **enter the gross score for the holes on which you have improved.**

A spreadsheet will be updated throughout the year and placed on the notice board.

BIRDIES COMPETITION



Enter EACH birdie you have in the book. After your first birdie of the season place your name on the top of a page and enter the hole number on which you had the birdie. The winner will be the person in each grade who has the most number of birdies for the year.

PUTTING COMPETITION

This year the Putting Competition will be run separately from the Eclectic and Birdies Competition. The cost of the Putting Competition will be \$5 payable to the Pro Shop.



The Putting Competition will be based on the best six putting rounds for the year and **if you don't submit six scores you are ineligible to win.** There are at least 20 stroke rounds (Medal & Mug days) during the period February to November, there are also the Garry Crick events and several other stroke rounds (including Club Championships and qualifiers for match play).

You don't have to be in the Eclectic & Birdies Competition to enter the Putting Competition.

If less than 6 women enter the Putting Competition it be a "winner take all" competition. If between 6 and 10 women enter there be 2 prizes at the end of the year. If there are more than 10 there will be first second & third prizes.

Enter the number of putts you have at the end of each STROKE round in the Putts book. After your first stroke round of the season place your name on the top of a page and enter your score.
