BY-LAWS

BY-LAW No1/2009

1 RECISSION OF PREVIOUS BY-LAWS

1.01 All By-Laws adopted by the Club prior to the adoption of this By-Law shall be rescinded upon adoption of this By-Law.

2 DRESS RULES

2.01 The minimum dress requirements on the Golf Course and in the Clubhouse is neat , tidy ,clean, casual dress at all times , other than in exceptional circumstances for which approval must be obtained from the General Manager or Staff Supervisor.

The following items of dress are not permitted

On the Course

- Shirts or tops with offensive slogans.
- Brief shorts, beach or football shorts.
- Football socks, thongs, moccasins or bare feet.
- Tee shirts without collars ("Mock Tees" excluded) or singlets
- Bikini Tops.

In the Clubhouse

- Shirts or tops with offensive slogans, singlets.
- Brief shorts, beach or football shorts.
- Football socks, moccasins, spiked golf shoes, bare feet.
- Hats.
- Bikini Tops

3 PERSONAL CONDUCT

3.01 General

All persons on the Club's property will be required to conduct themselves in an orderly manner so as not to cause nuisance or offence to other persons. Members will be responsible at all times for the conduct of their guests, on the Course, in the Clubhouse and elsewhere on the Club's property.

3.02 Bad Language

No person shall use inappropriate language whilst on the Club's property.

3.03 Smoking

No person shall smoke while within the ProShop or any portion of the Clubhouse other than the designated outdoor area.

3.04 Access

No person shall enter the kitchen, the cool room or the area behind the Bar , unless authorised by the Board or General Manager to do so.

3.05 Complaints

No person shall reprimand an officer or employee of the Club. Any complaint regarding staff or the conduct of a member shall be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary of the Club.

4 CHILDREN

4.01 No child shall be permitted to enter or remain in the clubhouse or on the course,(except for Junior Members of the Club whilst playing golf,) unless the child is accompanied by an adult member or guardian. The adult member or guardian shall be responsible for the proper conduct of the child.

5 FLOWERS AND SHRUBS

5.01 No person shall cut flowers, shrubs or trees anywhere within the Club's property unless authorized by the Board or General Manager to do so.

6 NOTICES

6.01 No person shall display or exhibit any notice or advertisements anywhere on or within the Club's property unless authorised by the General Manager or Board to do so.

7 RAFFLES AND DONATIONS

7.01 No person shall conduct a raffle or solicit donations anywhere within the Club's property without the consent of the General Manager.

8 CAR PARKING

8.01 No person shall park a vehicle within:

- (a) the spaces set aside for members of the Board, the Lady President, the Captains or members of staff
- (b) the service vehicle parking area at the rear of the clubhouse, or
- (c) in the Greenkeeper's area.

8.02 No person shall park a vehicle or golf buggy anywhere other than in the spaces provided for parking.

9 BREACHES OF BY-LAWS

9.01 Any breaches of the By-Laws shall be dealt with in accordance with the Rules relating to conduct unbecoming a member or prejudicial to the interests of the Club.

PRESENTATION POLICY

When on the premises any trophy winners must make themselves available to receive their awards, shake the hand of the Presenter, if offered, and properly observe a standard of social conduct which will not cause nuisance or offence to other persons.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in forfeiture of trophies

CLUBHOUSE INFORMATION

1. VISITORS

Visitors to the Club are required to comply with the provisions of the relevant Liquor Licensing and/or Gaming legislation, which include the following:-

- (i) Visitors must be registered in the Visitors Book and be signed in by a member.
- (ii) Persons residing within ten (10) kilometres of the Club are not permitted to enter the Clubhouse unless they become a Member of the Club.
- (iii) No person under the age of eighteen (18) years may enter the Gaming Room.

2. HOURS OF OPERATION

The hours during which the Bar and Gaming Room will be open will be such hours as may be adopted by the Board.

NOTE: Hours are extended during summer holiday period.

3. CHILDREN

Children are permitted to enter the Clubhouse providing they are accompanied by a parent or adult member who is required to supervise and control the children at all times.

4. CATERING

Snacks and meals are available in the Clubhouse at the times advertised by notice within the Clubhouse.

5. FUNCTIONS

Private functions may be arranged through the General Manager or Bar/Bistro Manager.

6. WARNING

Members are advised not to leave money or valuables in the Clubhouse.

PLAYING CONDITIONS:**GOLF COMMITTEE:**

The Golf Committees have complete control over all events played on the course.

Competitors in major events, pennant matches and club competitions have precedence over casual players on the course.

It is the custom of Golf Clubs to yield to the Presidents and Captains of the Club the rights of the Tee.

A competitor should read the notice board before beginning play. Local Rules are varied from time to time.

In any group the lowest handicap player is captain and is responsible for the observance of the rules and etiquette of the game.

Every player MUST carry and use a Sand Bucket to fill all divots. All plug marks MUST be repaired.

Call Holes: Some holes may be designated as Call Holes. All players are expected to observe and comply with the instructions displayed at any designated Call Hole.

Mobile Telephones: Any golfer who must carry a mobile telephone on the golf course, should ensure the telephone is turned off at all times other than in an emergency.

Slicks: Any golf buggy used on the course at any time must be fitted with slicks.

CONDITIONS OF USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON GOLF COURSE:

The following conditions are intended to ensure that any golfer using a motor vehicle on the golf course will do so in such a manner as to avoid causing damage to the course or any nuisance to other golfers.

1. Permission to use a motor vehicle on the course is granted as a privilege and as such may be withdrawn at any time at the discretion of the Board.
2. Operators of motor vehicles should always be aware of the need to avoid damage to the golf course and should:
 - (a) avoid crossing tees
 - (b) avoid crossing fairways within 10 metres of the front edge of any green;
 - (d) keep out of hazards or bunkers;
 - (e) as far as practicable, travel along the sides of fairways, particularly when the course is wet;
 - (f) avoid scuffing by the inside wheel when turning by following a path having a diameter of at least 10 metres;
 - (g) keep off the lawns and paths in front of the clubhouse;
 - (h) travel at a speed not exceeding normal walking pace;
 - (i) always proceed in such a manner as to avoid interference or nuisance to other golfers.

NOTE:

1. Motor vehicles may be loaded on to and unloaded from transporting vehicles on the special loading ramp at the south eastern corner of the car park.

2. The term "motor vehicle" as used in the above conditions includes all power operated vehicles ridden by the operator.

PRACTICE ON COURSE:

A Player may hit no more than two balls per hole.

SIX DAY MEMBERS

Six Day Members are not permitted to use any of the club's golf facilities on Saturdays

SPECIAL NOTE:

Australian Golf Union Handicaps (Maximum 36 for Men) and Women's Golf Australia Handicaps (Maximum 45 for Ladies) are to be used for all Open Tournaments.

HANDICAPS:

For Men - Three 18 hole stroke scores must be returned for an initial handicap to be allotted. Five 18 hole stroke cards must be returned each calendar year to retain a handicap.

For Ladies -Three 9 hole or 18 hole stroke scores must be returned for an initial handicap to be allotted. Three 9 hole or 18 hole stroke cards must be returned each calendar year to retain a handicap.

ENTERING COMPETITIONS:

To enter a competition a competitor must, before commencing play, register his or her intention to compete by:

- (a) paying the appropriate fee;
- (b) registering his or her name on the GolfLink terminal either at the club or via the internet; OR, when such terminal is not in use, by entering his or her name on an entry list kept for the purpose

Failure to pay the entry fee before commencing play shall disqualify the competitor from the competition

COMPETITION TIMES:

Saturday competitions must be commenced by 1.00pm or such other time as may be fixed by the Golf Committee.

RETURN OF SCORE CARDS:

Competitors score cards must be returned immediately on completion of a round, be signed by the marker, countersigned by the competitor and show the competitor's correct handicap. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in disqualification.

All competition score cards must be returned.

Each competitor is responsible for the return of his or her scorecard.

TIES:

Men's Events

Should there be a tie in any grade of the Club Championships, or in the Monthly Medal the event will be decided by a play off over 18 holes, except that where there is a gross and nett section of the same event the nett result shall be decided by count back. If after 18 holes, the event is still tied, the play off will continue hole by hole until a result is reached.

Play offs shall take place on the date specified by the Golf Committee. Ties in all other events shall be decided by count-back as follows:

1. For 18 hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last 6 holes or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from 18th.

2. In 27, 36, 54 and 72 hole events, the last 18 holes shall be used and if still tied count-back as in 1. above.
3. In handicap events, the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied. (Refer Rule 33-6)
