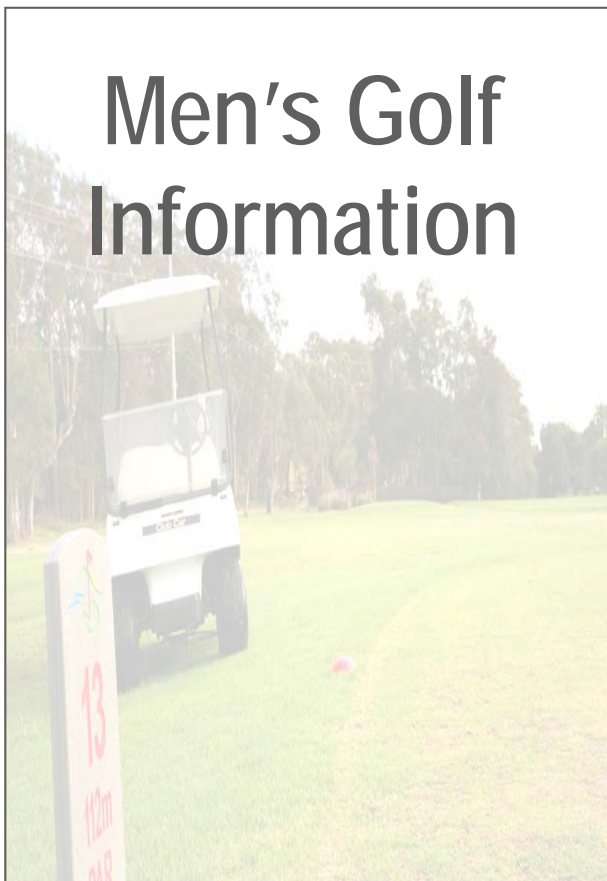

MEMBERS' ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE FOLLOWING CLUB REGULATIONS

NEW MEMBERS

It is the responsibility of the Proposer and Seconder immediately a Nominee is elected to membership to see the new member is introduced to other members, is advised of the rules governing the conduct of the Club and, above all, is sufficiently advanced in the knowledge of the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duty of marker to a fellow competitor. Please see that you play with the Nominee until he is thus prepared.

VISITORS

All visitors to the Club should be properly recorded in the visitors book by the accompanying member immediately on arrival at the Clubhouse. This is a requirement of the Liquor Act and *must* be strictly observed.

GENERAL

Spikes are not allowed in the Clubhouse.

Only buggies with wide slick tyres may be used on the golf course.

Mobile phones must be switch off or not taken onto the golf course.

SPECIAL NOTES TO MEMBERS

The co-operation and assistance of all members in observing the above requirements will assist the various committees to carry out their respective duties and obligations to your satisfaction. Check your card, hole by hole, with your marker before signing and handing in. Failure to do so might cause disqualification.

All competition cards must be handed in. Bring any complaints to the attention of the sub-committee concerned. Harmony is very important.

The spirit of a golf club is given to it by its members.

ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

1. No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or playing a stroke.
2. The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before his opponent or fellow competitor tees his ball.
3. No player should play until the party in front is out of range.
4. In the interests of all, players should play without delay.
5. A player who has incurred a penalty should intimate the fact to his opponent or marker as soon as possible.
6. Players searching for a ball should allow players coming up on them to pass. They should signal to the players following them to pass and should not continue to play until those in front are out of range.
7. Through the green, a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him is replaced at once and divots filled with sand.
8. Any damage to the putting green made by the ball or a player is to be carefully repaired.
9. Players should ensure that, when dropping bags or the flagstick, no damage is done to the green, and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to it, or in handling the flagstick. The flagstick should be squarely and properly replaced before leaving the green.
10. When the result of a hole has been determined, the players should immediately leave the green.
11. Players should not stand in the line of their opponent's or partner's putt. If they cannot putt out, they are requested to mark their ball.
12. Members must make every effort to familiarise themselves with the Rules of Golf.
13. Members are requested to take sand buckets to fill divot marks and protect the course at all times.
14. It is the responsibility of the lowest marker in the group to ensure that the above points are carried out.
15. To help keep the club friendly, players are requested to share social time with persons with whom they played that day.

SLOW PLAY CAN BE PENALISED

If there is clear fairway in front of you, your group is too slow. These hints will help:

- a) Don't delay at your tee if those in front of you are out of range. Hit first and mark the card later.
- b) Go to your own ball first – be ready to play without delay when your turn comes.
- c) Watch the ball until it comes to rest. Mark its position with some object.
- d) Clean your ball regularly during the game – it will be much easier to find.
- e) Leave the green as soon as the hole is completed.

NOTE:

- a) Repair lob marks on the green.
- b) Smooth out sand after playing a shot from the bunker.
- c) Fill divots with sand both on the fairway and in the rough.

HANDICAPS

Stroke Play

All competitions are played of full handicap.

Match Play

Strokes taken are the difference between handicaps.

American Foursomes

$\frac{1}{4}$ combined handicaps.

Canadian Foursomes

$\frac{1}{2}$ combined handicaps.

Ambrose

4 players: $\frac{1}{8}$ of combined handicaps.

3 players: $\frac{1}{6}$ of combined handicaps.

2 players: $\frac{1}{4}$ of combined handicaps.

Note: No restrictions of "A" Grade players per Ambrose team

METHOD OF COMPETITION PLAY

FOURSOMES

Two players play as partners and use the same ball. The partners strike off alternate tees and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play at each hole. Scoring is down as for a stroke round and the total is subject to a deduction of half of the aggregate handicaps.

Note; If either player incurs a penalty stroke it does not alter the rotation of play.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Played as above except that **both** players strike tee shots at each hole. They must then nominate which ball they will continue to play. Afterwards they continue to play whichever ball they nominated, with the partner hitting the selected ball. Handicap is half of the aggregate handicaps.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players strike tee shots at each hole, then play a second shot with their partner's ball. They must then nominate which ball they will continue to play. Play continues as in foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Handicap is 1/4 of the aggregate handicap.

(This event is sometimes called "Pinehurst Foursomes")

AMBROSE

Each player in every team must use and record 2 drives per round. The selected drive is then taken and the other balls are to played within one club length. On the green, one putter head length is allowed from the selected ball. Each player is allowed to putt out until the lowest score is recorded on the hole.

ROOSTERS

"Roosters" – 6.00am to 8.00am commence Sunday 28th November 2010.
Individual in grades, Long drives, Nearest to the pins, snack at the 9th.
Last day, Sunday 27th February 2011 – shotgun start, meal and presentation after 18 holes.

GENERAL GOLF INFORMATION

Starting timesheets are available two (2) weeks in advance of the competition day.

Visitors are not permitted to book on the timesheets until one (1) week in advance of the competition day.

Members are requested to observe booking times, failure to do so will result in player being moved to the end of the competition field.

Players must report to the starter at least 10 minutes before their booked time.

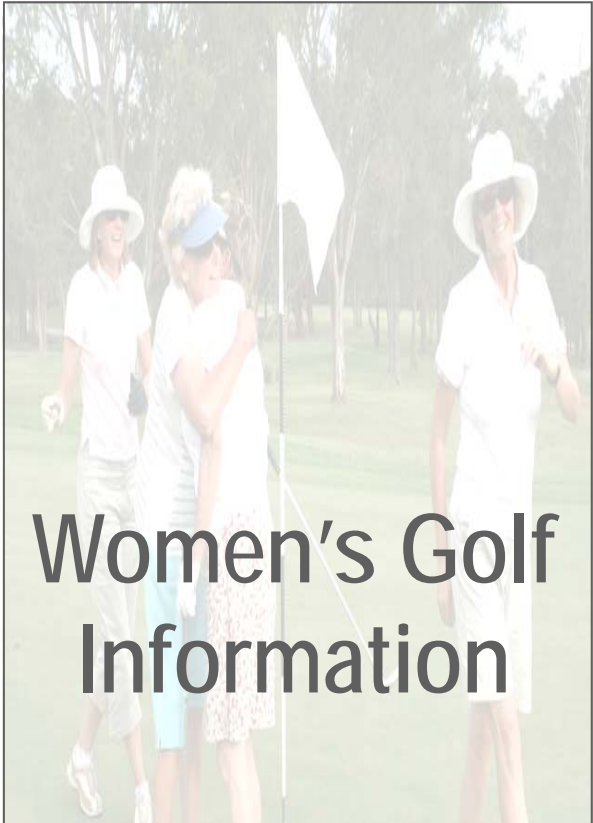
