

## Coating Inspection Refresher

**Duration** 1 day

**Description** In 1993, the ACA Council decided that the ACA Coating Inspection Certificate would have a five year life, bringing us in line with similar schemes in New Zealand, the UK and USA. As a result, after five years, the certificate needs to be updated and so the ACA Coating Inspection Refresher course is designed to ensure that inspectors keep their knowledge up-to-date.

While many inspectors will carry out a number of important tests in their work, it is likely that they will not use all the methods covered in the ACA Coating Inspection Course. This refresher is designed to review and revise the main inspection methods.
